Subject: Summer Renovation Projects

Monday, May 1 marks the start of demolition of the three buildings on the west side of our block in anticipation of excavation for the construction of our new building.

I also want to apprise you of related summer renovation projects on the third floor of the Kresge Library as well as in classrooms E0530 and E1530.

The east side of the third floor of the Kresge Library will be renovated to construct 16 small interview rooms that will serve as OCD interview rooms during interview season and student group study rooms when not needed for OCD or Admissions interviewing. OCD support staff will be located in the former K3318 conference room now occupied by Research Support. The staff of Research Support will be relocated to K3341, a former conference room within the Kresge Library administrative staff area. The east side of the third floor will be closed to faculty, staff, and students during the construction period, and the restroom facilities on the floor will be unavailable for use. Public restrooms on the 2nd floor of the building will remain in service for staff, students, and faculty. Construction is projected to occur between May 15 and August 1.

Flat classrooms E0530 and E1530 will be converted to tiered classrooms during this same time period. In addition, electrical and data ports will be added to the student stations of K1310 and K1320 and E0540, E0550, E1540, and E1550.

There will be some noise and disruption associated with these renovation projects. We will appreciate your understanding as these important renovations are accomplished during the upcoming summer months.
