- **Business Databases** are found on Kresge's 'A-Z Database List.' We provide over 90 electronic business resources to Ross students wherever you find yourself.
- Kresge Library Research Guides and Wiki Pages are growing resources from Kresge Library. These tools allow us to more easily share information such as database hints, key journals, and direct links to resources. You will also find guides and wiki pages to support your research assignments at Ross.
- Video Tutorials and the Kresge Library Dash (Podcast Series) provide quick and efficient ways to help you use our electronic resources.
- **Database Instruction Handouts** are useful for learning more about particular databases. The handouts page also includes the schedule of upcoming sessions.

- We have access to over 90 business databases at Kresge Library, and resources of the University of Michigan Libraries, one of the best library systems in the world.
- Ross students have access to all library resources at the University, as well as databases licensed just for the Ross Community.

- We manage the coursepack operations for Ross classes that use business cases, articles, simulations, and course handouts. Starting this summer, we will be distributing all coursepacks electronically via Study.net. Students will be able to purchase an optional print TEXTPACKs which could be useful in classes where electronic devices are not allowed.

Kresge Library is focused on service

- At Kresge Library, service is our brand. We work diligently with all students, faculty and staff at the Ross School of Business to help identify the best resources for whatever research project you might be working on.
- The Kresge librarians can help you with any information needs while at Ross. This might include: classwork assignments, case competitions, career search, clubs and extra-curricular, or even a simple curiosity. We call this the 5Cs!
- You can chat with a librarian right on the Kresge homepage. We staff our chat service typically from 10am to 10pm Monday through Thursday (during Fall and Winter Terms) and abbreviated hours over the weekend.
- For MBA students during MAP, your team will have an assigned librarian who will be able to help you identify resources that will help with your project. This allows you to dig deeper into your topic.
- Starting this fall, we providing the new Ross Exam Viewing and Assignment Distribution Service (located in Legal Research 102 in the Law Quad). This will be the same location as TEXTPACK pickup.
