

Richard E. Boyatzis is Professor of Organizational Behavior at the Weatherhead School of Management at Case Western Reserve University and a Visiting professor at ESADE in Barcelona. While at Case, he has served as Associate Dean of Executive Education and Chair of the Department of Organizational Behavior. Before becoming a professor, he was CEO of McBer and Company (a research HR consulting company for 11 years) and COO of Yankelovich, Skelly & White (a market research company for 2 years). He is the author of more than 100 articles on behavior change, leadership, competencies, and emotional intelligence. His books include: *The Competent Manager*; *Transforming Qualitative Information*; *Innovations in Professional Education: Steps on a Journey from Teaching to Learning* (with Scott Cowen and David Kolb); and co-author of the international best-seller, *Primal Leadership: Realizing the Power of Emotional Intelligence* with Daniel Goleman and Annie McKee. Professor Boyatzis has a BS in Aeronautics and Astronautics from MIT and a MS and Ph.D. in Social Psychology from Harvard University.
