Vinay co-founded BlueGill Technologies, an Internet infrastructure company that specialized in Internet billing software, in 1996. BlueGill was sold to CheckFree Corporation in 2000 for \$250 million, making it one of the most successful IT startups in Ann Arbor history. Following the acquisition, he served as Vice President of operations for CheckFree i-Solutions.

Prior to the launch of BlueGill Technologies, Vinay held management positions at Cabletron Systems, NCR Corporation, and Zenith Data Systems.

Vinay earned a MBA from the University of Michigan, and is an Adjunct Lecturer at the University of Michigan's Ross School of Business, teaching New Venture Creation.

He currently serves on the Board of Directors of Janeeva, Translume, and MMP, a multi-specialty physician group serving South East Michigan.
